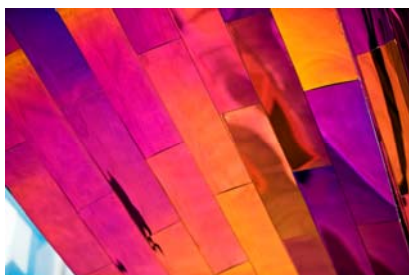

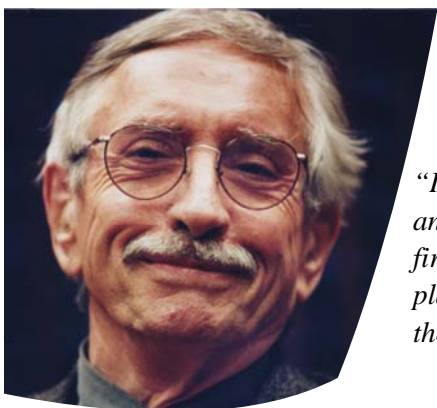

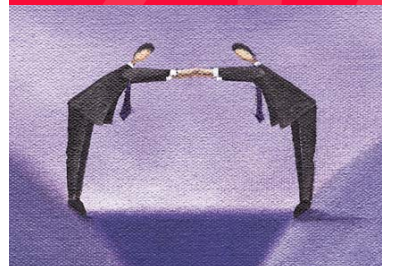
EDWARD ALBEE'S

AT HOME AT THE ZOO

"When Edward Albee's one-act play *The Zoo Story* debuted in 1959, it established Albee as one of America's most exciting new dramatists. A riveting and disturbing two-character work, the play concerns a battle over a park bench between mild-mannered publisher Peter and a volatile passerby named Jerry. Although *The Zoo Story* has become one of the most produced one-acts in American theater, Albee considered the play incomplete. In 2003 he penned *Homelife*, a prequel to *The Zoo Story* that takes place at the home belonging to Peter and his wife, Ann. The two one-acts now form the full-evening work *At Home at the Zoo*, which is making its local premiere in a new production from the Philadelphia Theatre Company."
